



Predator Urine - Plate 1

Predators mark their territory through the use of their urise. These territorial lines are "drawn" and "redrawn" again and again. There is good reason to think that animals. Predator urine is a good medium for any depiction of human

intruston into nature. While this intrusion essentially is a pissing-context, predator urine drawings are particularly suited to portrait a somewhat adolescent and playful inter-action of humans in nature.

Turn your drawing so that you can make the brush strokes in the direction that is most natural for your hand. Refiain from covering every hit of your paper. The white spaces are important because they make a contrast with the areas covered by lines.

The brush is a very versatile tool. Experiment with it for all types of lines. Carefully wash out your brush with soap and water after

using it. With proper care, it will last you a long time.


Contact Electrification and the Electric Current - Plate 5 Pictures made out of electrical current are an important tool in the arsenal of a missionary artist due to their trans-mitting qualities and their latent nature.


By fashioning your picture out of an electrochemical couple. like copper and non, it can take the form of a Baglidad Battery. This is an old medium: the production of electric charges by

the mere contact of two dissimilar metals was first discovered by Rev. Abraham Bennett, in 1789, and verified by a different method by Tiberius Cavalle, in 1795. Use wine, lemon juice, grape juice, or vinegar as an artidic electrolyte solution to generate the electric current from the difference between the electrochemical potentials of the copper and iron electrodes.

copper and tros electrones. While large externally powered electro magnetic trans-mitters have been successfully used by missionary artists for motifs of plain landscapes, the electro-chemical version of this medium is well suited for smaller scenes of political power or power variaul.
